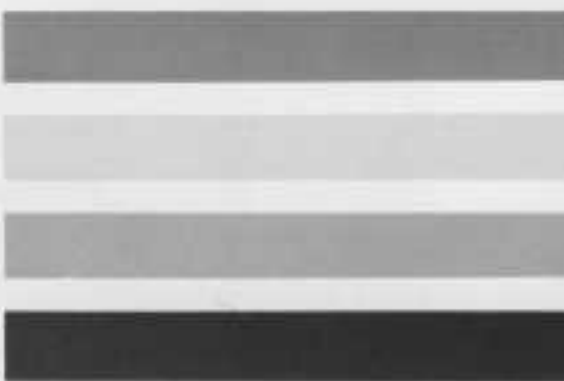

# This Page Is Dedicated to Mr. Ken Pattison Who Gave So Much to K.C.S.S.

Mr. Pattison, our Technical Director, is retiring this year after 22 years at K.C.S.S. No one teacher has had a greater dedication to a cause - the promotion of technical education - than he has. Ken worked tirelessly to inaugurate the co-op program in his department, and in doing so, played an instrumental role in developing the overall school co-op program into what it is today.

His early years were spent on a farm in the Republic of Ireland where he attended the local National School and, later, the Secondary School in Dublin. Mr. Pattison was quite active in many sports, especially rugby, field hockey cricket and badminton.

By 1957 he had sailed for Canada and married his wife, Irene. In the Toronto area by 1962 Ken then decided to attend the College of Education which he graduated from in 1965. After two years of teaching in London he moved to King.

Over the years this always innovative teacher has had quite an impact upon the school. He has introduced many other ideas to his department besides co-op; the packaging of shops, work experience programs, class trips to colleges such as Centennial and Conestoga, outings to industries such as Dofasco and Magna International, the Technical Career Day held two years ago and his constant encouragement and assistance to the '88-'89 Job Fair.

Ken has made a solid contribution to the sports program in our school as a coach of many rugby teams. On a personal level we remember his participation in the staff shot putting contest and his unequalled dexterity in slow pitch.

What are his future plans? For one thing he will not be retiring in the normal sense. He intends to travel and to devote more time to his favourite hobby of driving Connemara ponies. He will undoubtedly add to his already large collection of ribbons in this sport.

We will be able to replace the tech. director but we will never be able to replace the man. He was a most competent and caring teacher and a superior person. It was always a source of pride to him when a former student returned to boast of his accomplishments and successes in life.

We will miss Ken Pattison and wish him good luck and a pleasant retirement to a whole new lifestyle; a lifestyle that he will, of course, pursue in the slightly slower lane!

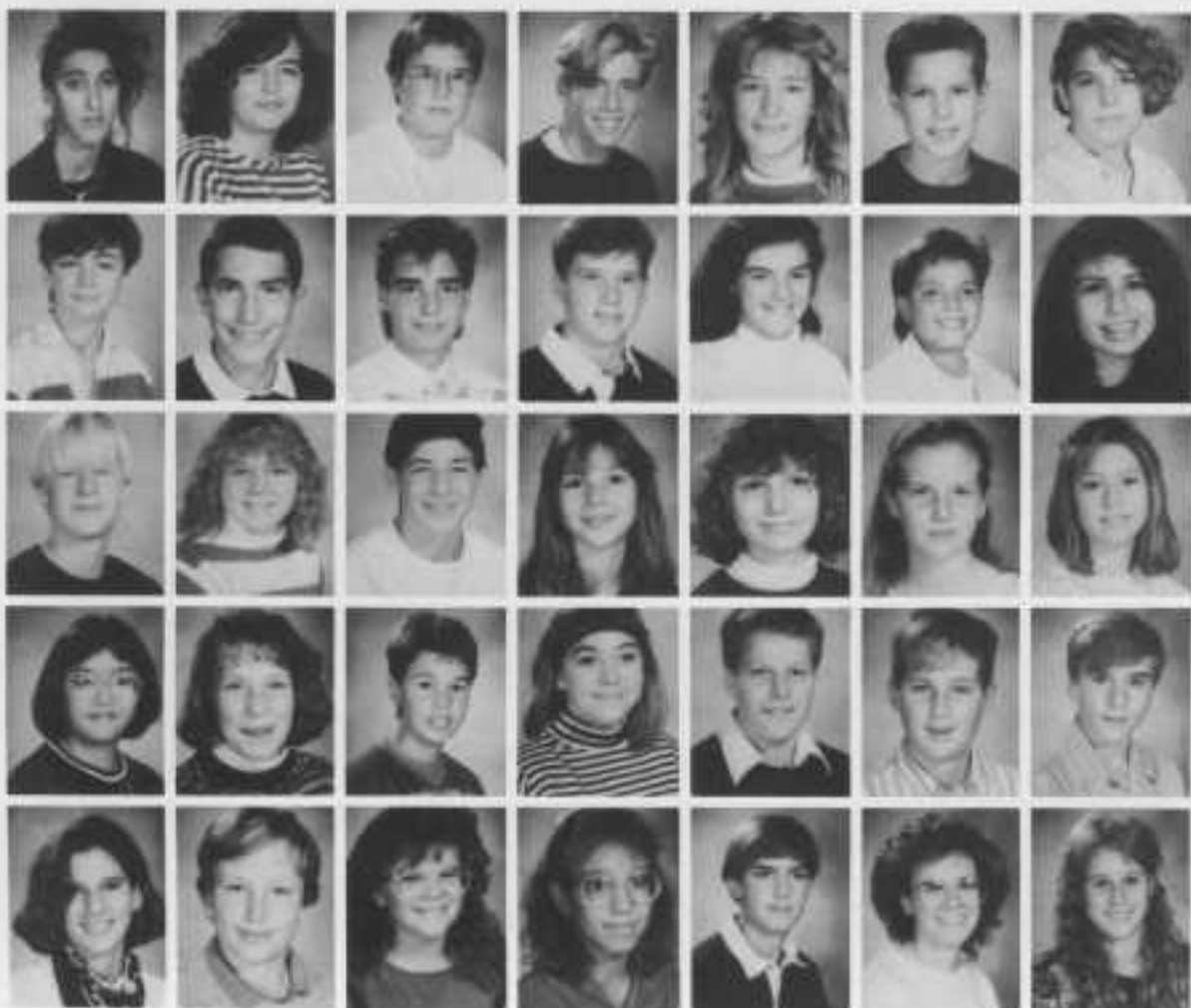

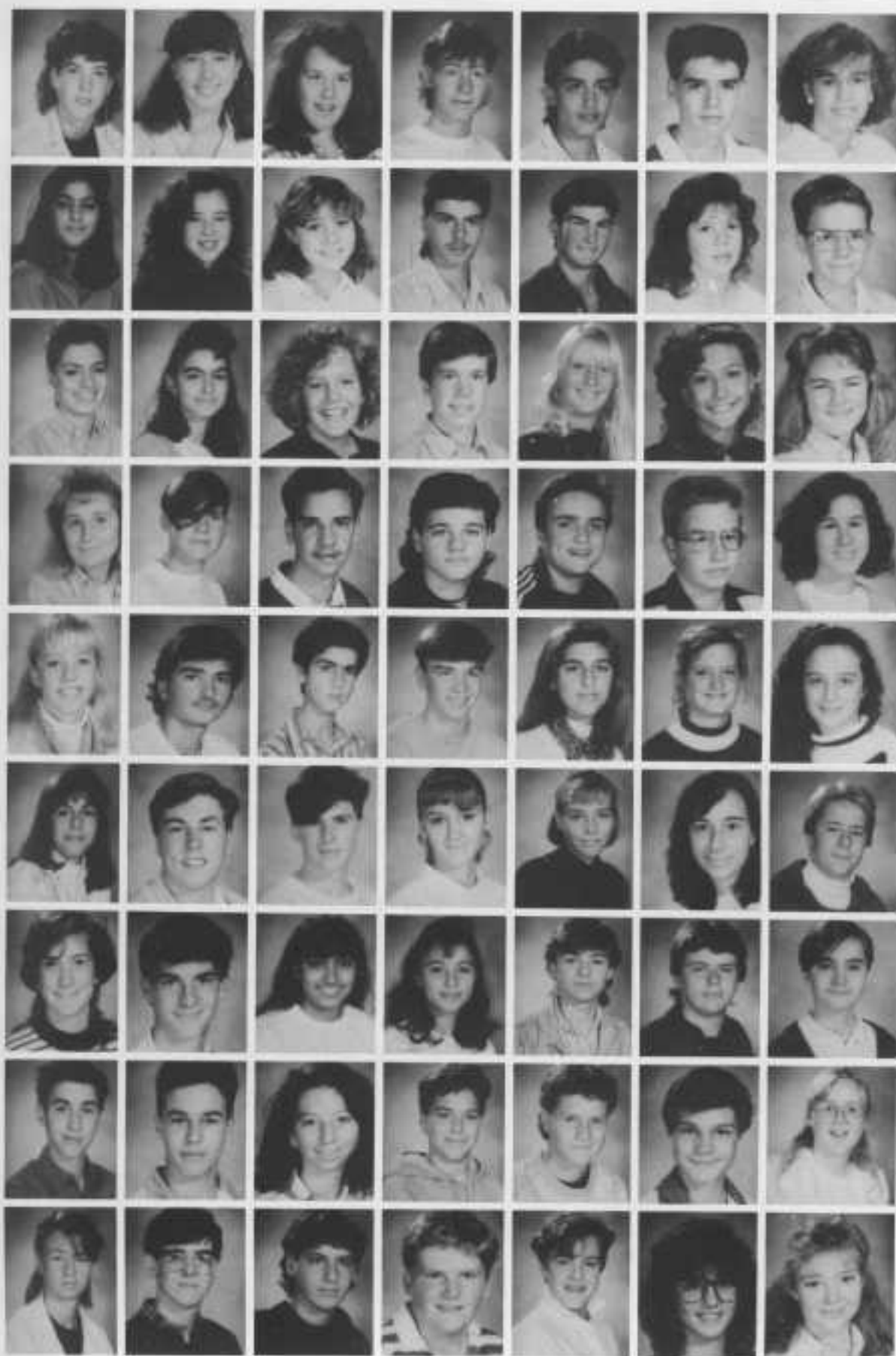

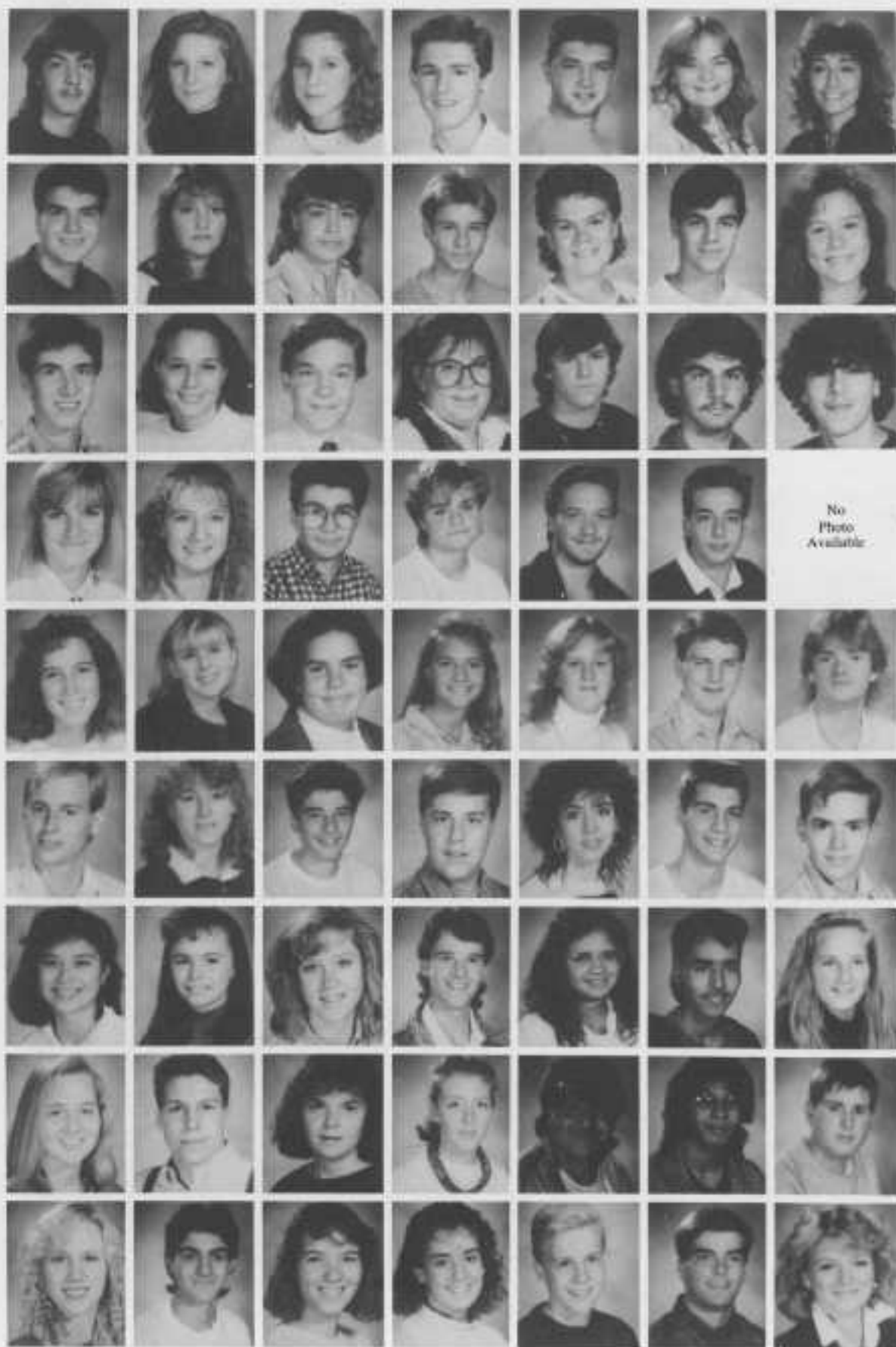
