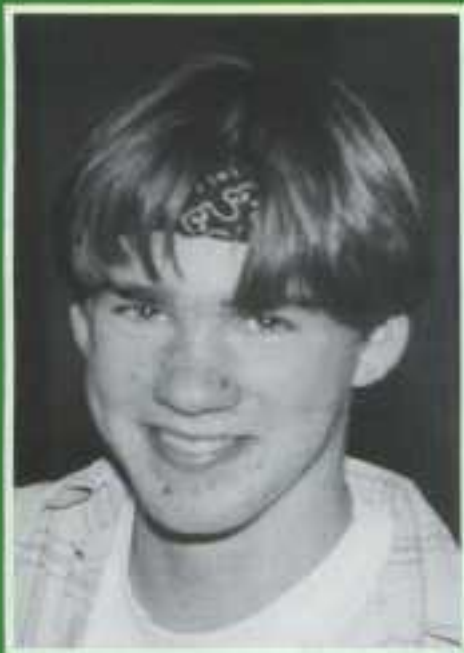

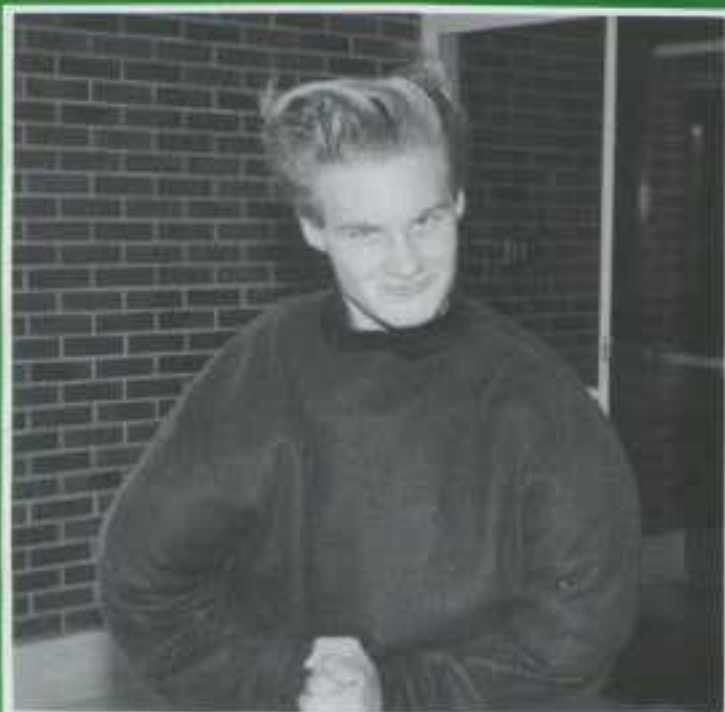




# Boo!

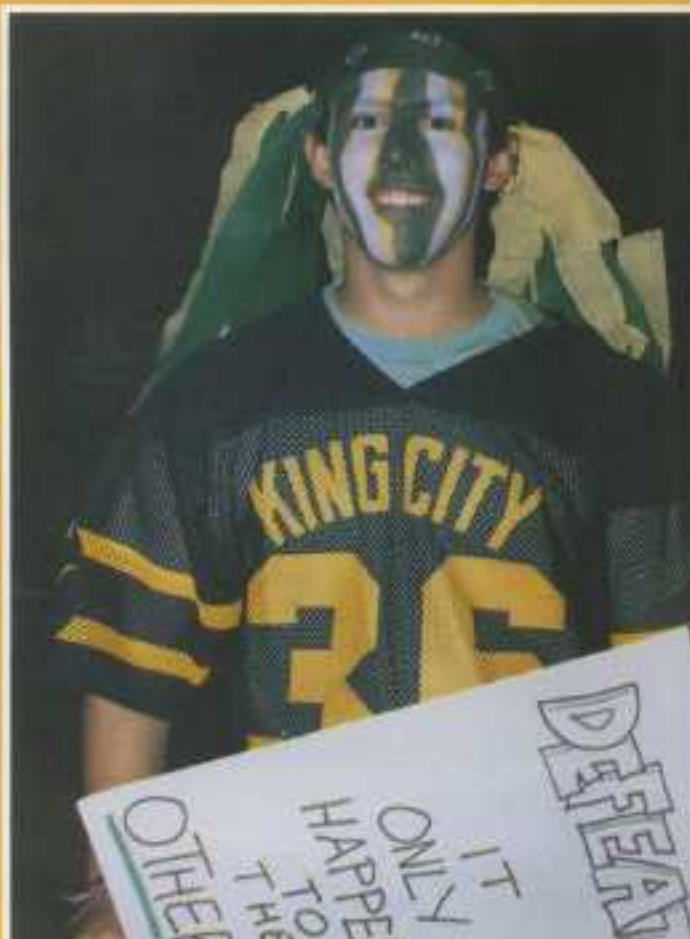

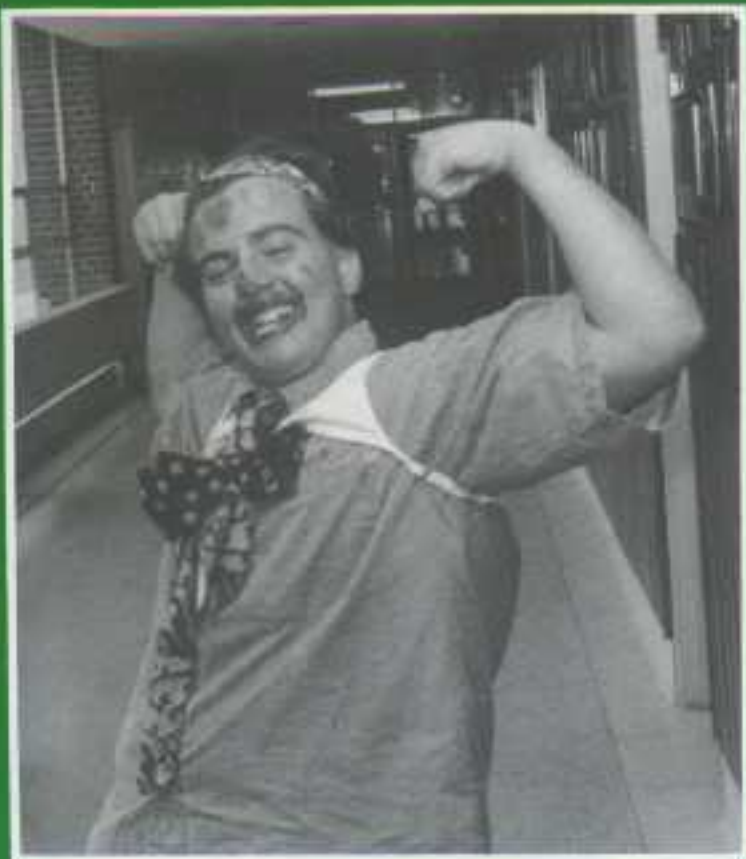
# Slave To The Grind

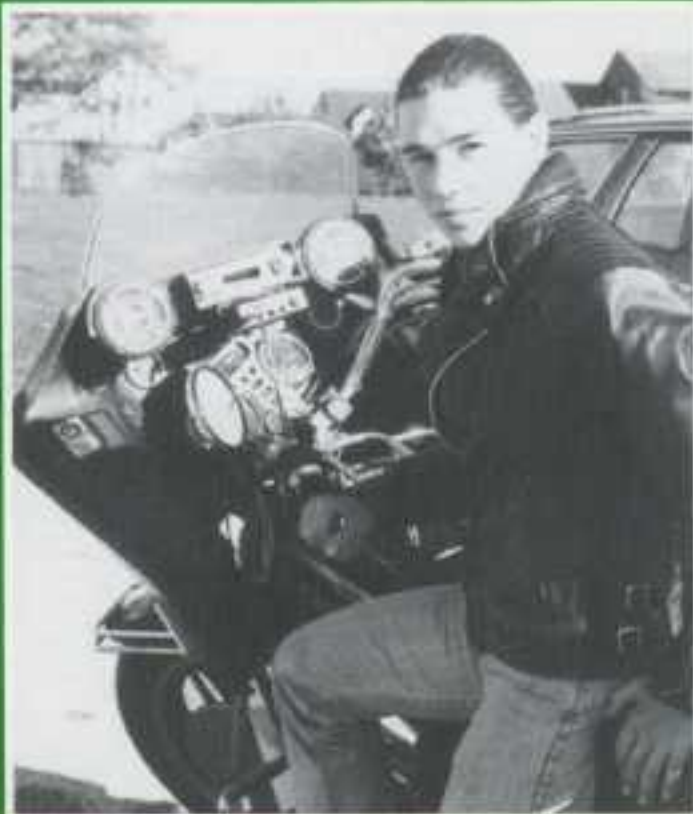

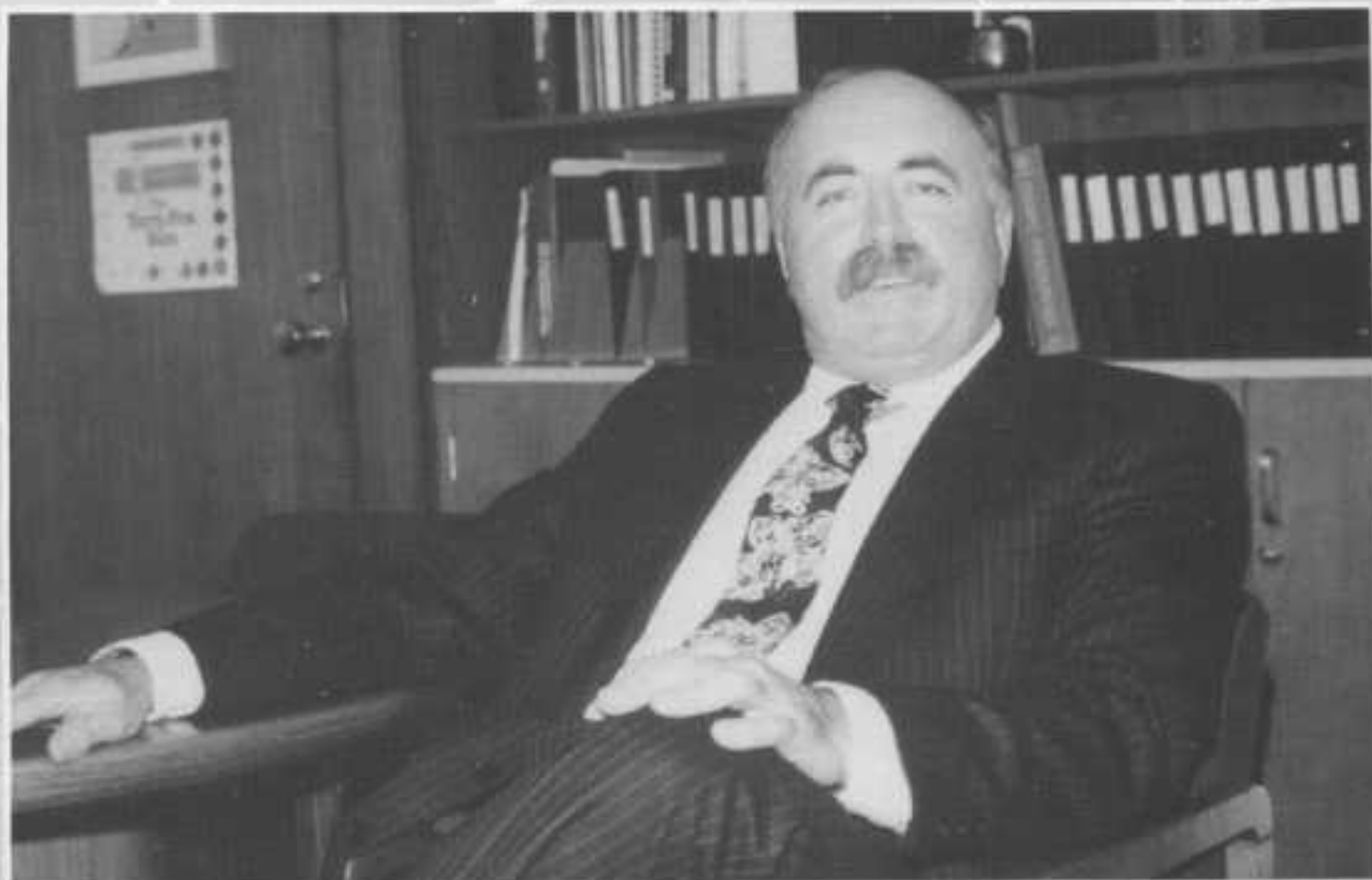

No longer can we as Canadians rely on what we take out of the ground for our high standard of living but rather what we take out of our minds.

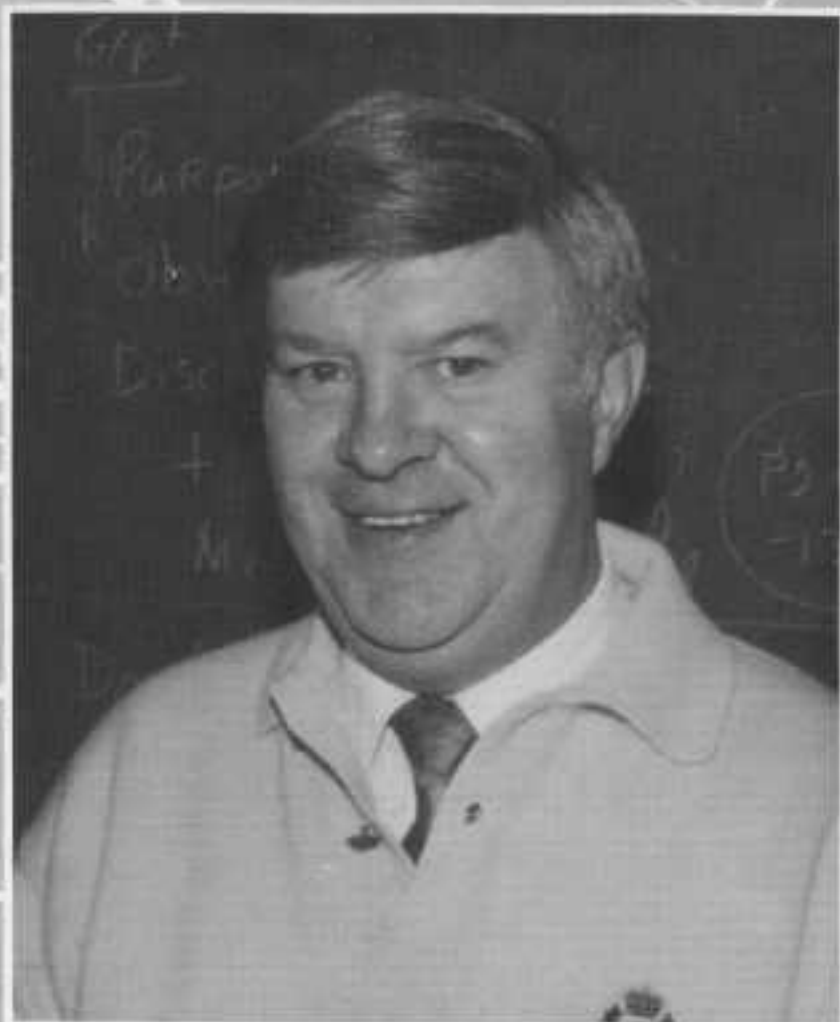
