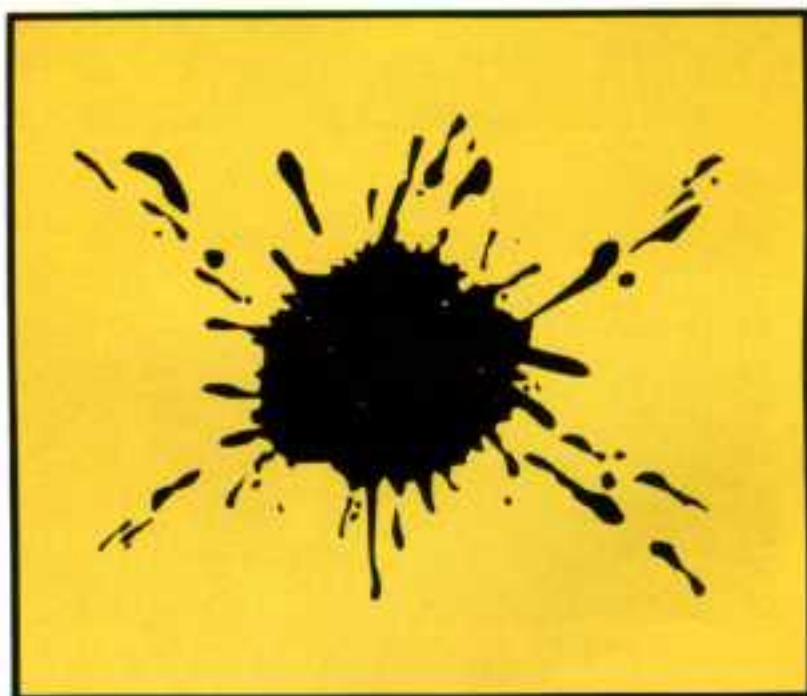




# TRICK-ORTREAT

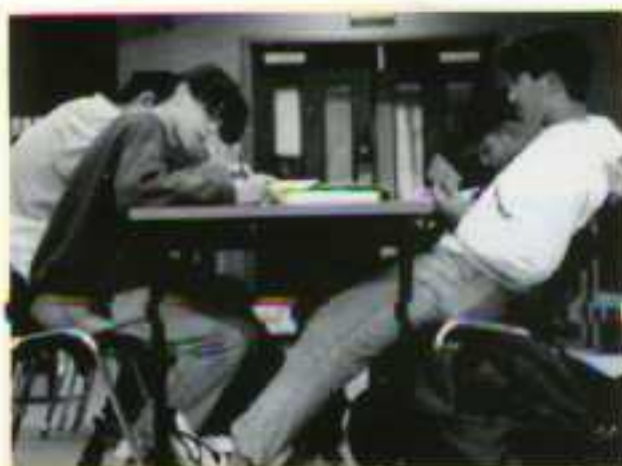






# STUDY HALL

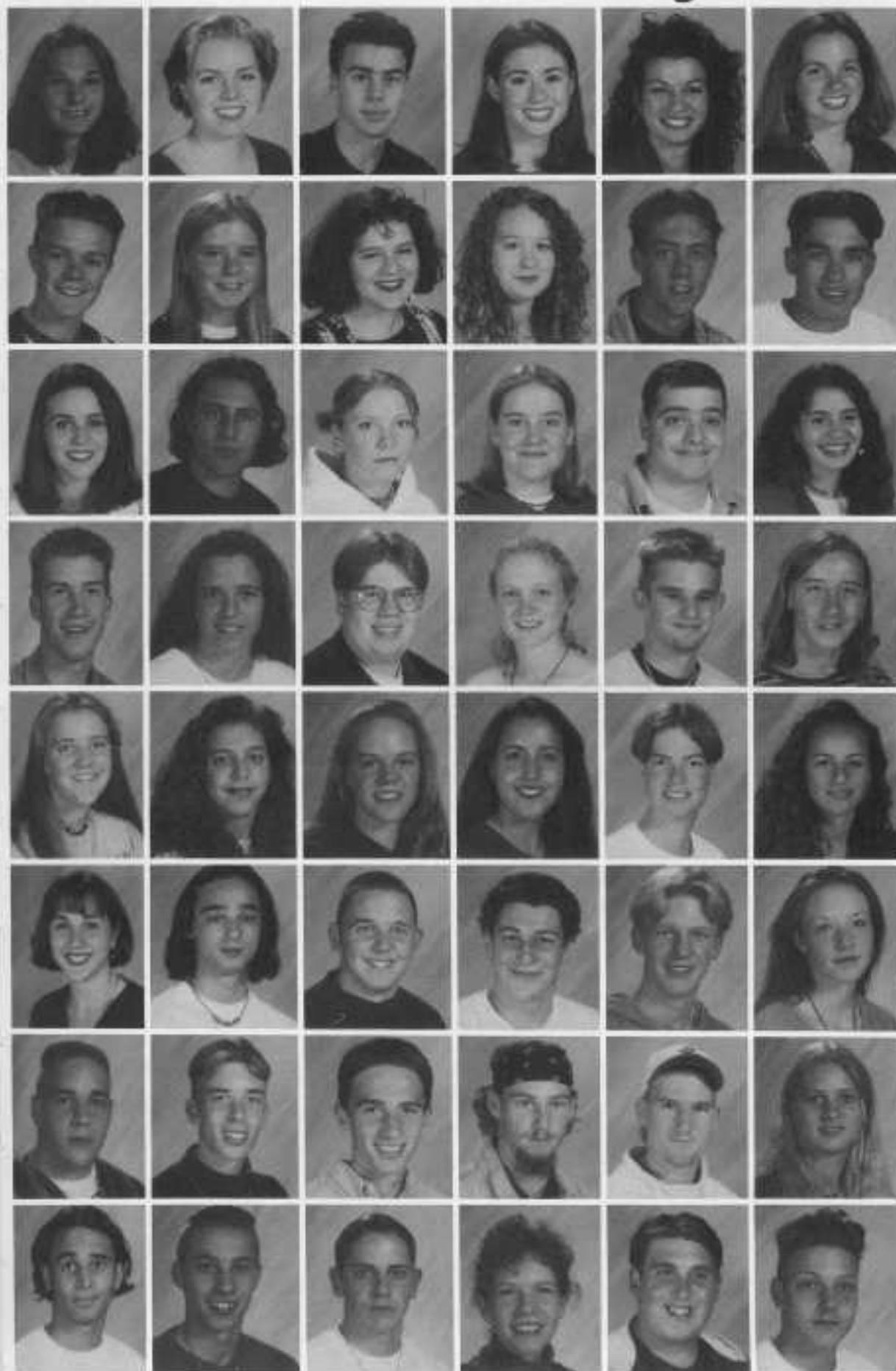

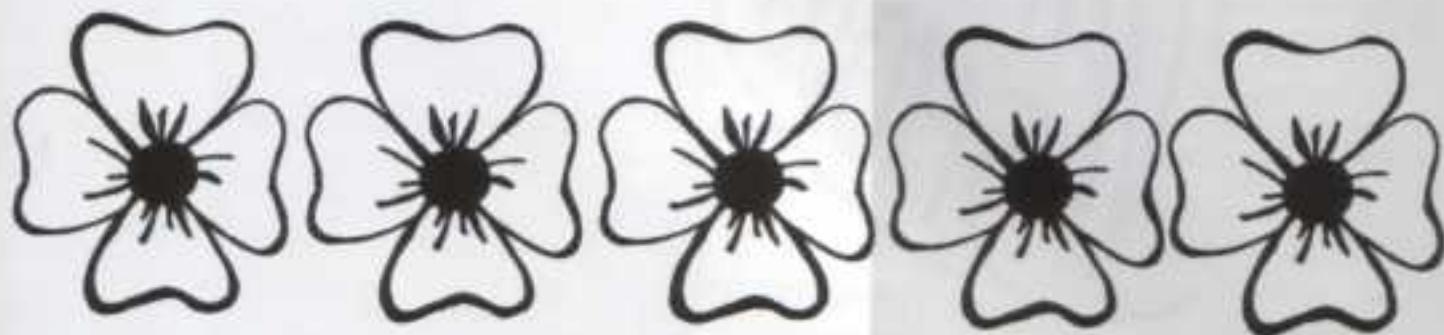
# Commencement and Junior Awards

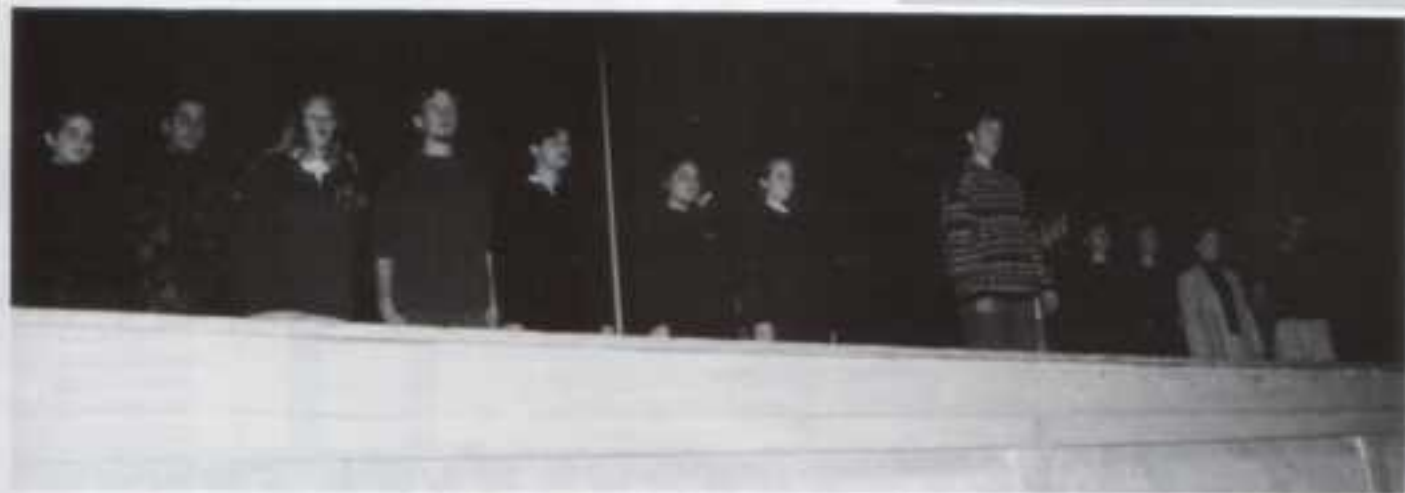




# Remembrance Day Assembly

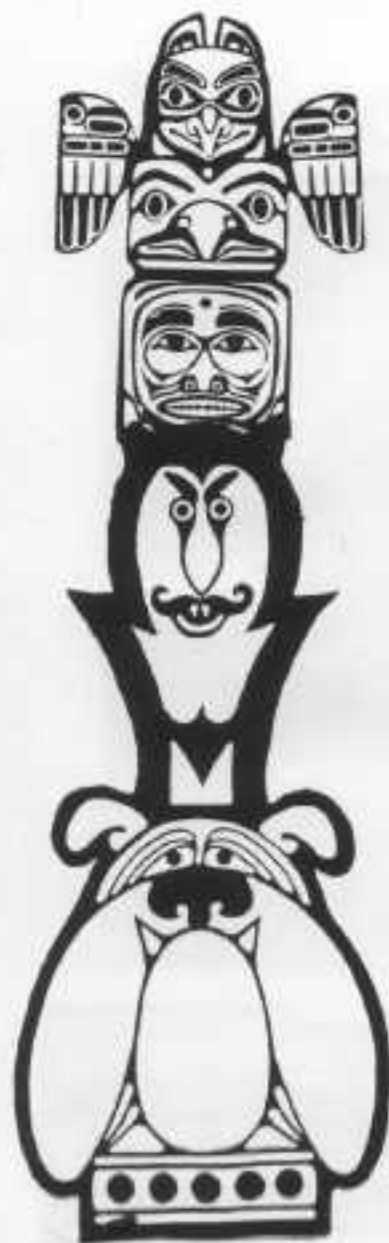

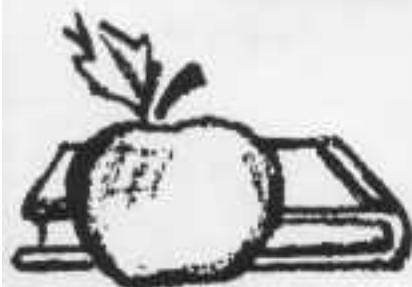

## S.A.C.

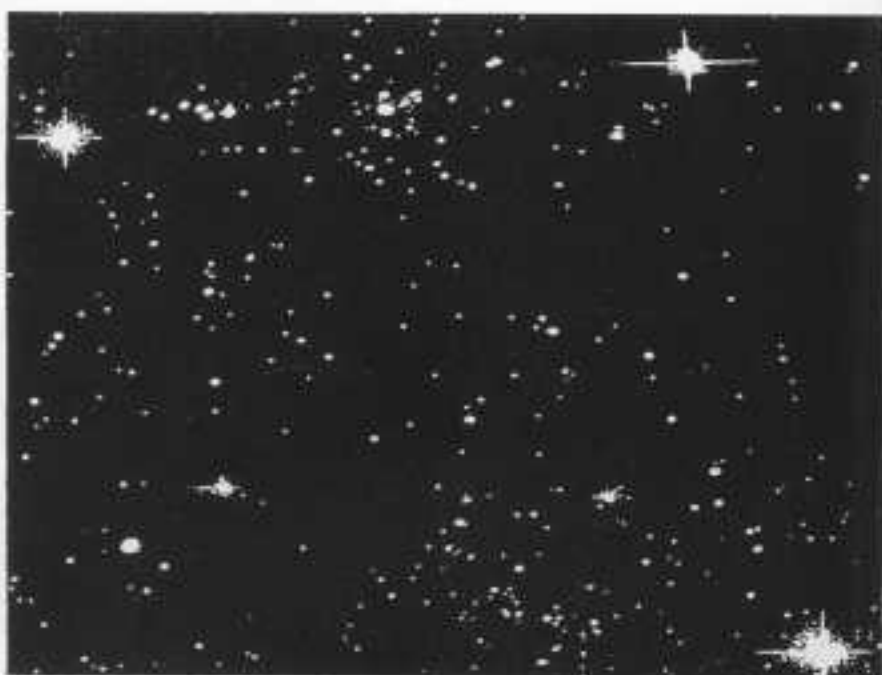
