






Top: It looks to us like #5 is about to score a goal. I guess the opponents just weren't good enough to match our team.



Back at school, after the two week protest, the "Green Ribbon" campaign was launched to support awareness of concerns.


With the recent passing of Bill 160, we're not sure where education in the future is headed. All we can do is thank our teachers for all their positive efforts and hope for the best.












Grade ten has come and gone
