








All That Glitters Is Gold

Catching the last of the sun's rays, friends reflect on the summer's fun. Tara and Ashleigh can be found spending time together in the great outdoors.












Freshly mined golden dust

These grade 9 girls brave the cool autumn air to enjoy a healthy lunch at the plaza.






Teachers that are leaving, but will not be forgotten.


SPIRIT WEEK
