"This was definitely the best year ever," said Michelle Suhku. "There was an amazing amount of school spirit". School spirit however, was just one of the many things that students learned.







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
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If a quiet place surrounded by familr faces captures your heart's desire, then inhleton is probably the place to be.

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
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WOODBRIDGE "See you at Coffee Time."
