




The King City Boys Hockey team was named for another successful year. With new coach Mr.

Roc-King Award

History

In the year 1960 AD construction began on what is now King City Secondary School; however, on the first attempt to break ground for the new school, the contractor was met by a strange obstacle. The jaw-like boulder smashed into the soft, rich soil and was repelled by a piece of rock. Three years later the shovel was thwarted by this rock, until finally the consulting engineers decided to move the cornerstone for the school's foundation about 5 inches to the east. It was not to ever, major geological trust us in the world and each time it defied identification. It was returned to King City where upon the Senior Football Coach, decided to award it to the most outstanding player for each game. The player receiving the rock was to carry it with him until the next game. It has been observed that there exists reciprocal relationship between the rock and its possessor. The players infuse the rock with their characteristics of intestinal fortitude, partnerships with their talent, and their never-say-die attitude. And so through the years the Rock has taken on additional strength while passing it onto its possessor, its already unrecognizable characteristic.




